

# PRIVACY NOTICE

**ASEAN 5G & OT Security Summit (5GOT 2025)** is committed to respecting your personal data and takes the matter of protecting your privacy as high priority. This privacy policy applies to 5GOT 2025 website, event, app and other service (each, a “Service”) that refers or links to this privacy policy. This privacy policy may be supplemented by additional privacy statements, terms or notices provided to you. The 5GOT 2025 owns or administers the Service, as identified therein, is the primary controller of your personal information provided to, or collected by or for, the Service. By submitting your personal data to us, you will be treated as having given your permission (whenever necessary) for disclosures referred to in our policy herein.

## Information We Collect

We may collect your personal information from the following :

- From your input through our registration system, and other badge scanners, app forms and other mechanisms.
- Any other information voluntarily provided through forms or correspondence

## Data You Provide To Us

The types of personal information that we collect directly from you depends on how you interact with us and the Service and may include:

- Contact details, such as name, email address, postal address, and phone number;
- Account login credentials, such as username and password and similar security information;
- Other account or event registration and profile information, such as educational, employment and professional background, dietary and accessibility requirements, and photo;
- Payment information, such as credit or debit card number;

- Comments, feedback and other information you provide to us, including information that you send to customer support and messages, appointment inquiries and other information that you wish us to share with our exhibitors, visitors, partners and others;
- Sensitive data revealing health, disability, religion, or race or ethnic origin, as part of a request for special assistance or dietary requirements or in a medical emergency; and/or

## Data From Service Use or Attendance

Our Service may automatically collect information about how you and your device interact with the Service, including:

- Computer, device and connection information, such as IP address, browser type and version, operating system, platform and other software installed on your device, unique device identifier and other technical identifiers, error reports and performance data;
- Usage data, such as the features you used, the settings you selected, your URL click stream data, including date and time stamp and referring and exit pages, and pages you visited on the Service; and/or
- For location-aware Services, your location data, such as where you are located on the event floor.

We collect this data through our servers and the use of cookies and other technologies, including Bluetooth, RFID and QR Code.

You can control or limit location data collected through mobile applications by changing your preferences in your device's location services preferences menu or through your choices regarding the use of Bluetooth and other network interfaces you may use to interact with our Service. However, use of RFID technologies, such as QR Code may be necessary for you to access certain events.

We also collect footage and imagery captured through recording, photography, or CCTV at events, offices and other locations.

## How We Use Your Information

Depending on how you interact with us and the Service, we use your personal information to:

- Provide, activate and manage your access to and use of the Service, including your attendance at events;
- Process and fulfil a request, order, download or other transaction;
- Provide customer, technical, product and other support and to help keep the Service working, safe and secure;
- Offer you customised content and other personalisation to make the Service more relevant to your interests and geography;
- Respond to your requests, inquiries, comments and concerns;
- Notify you about changes, updates and other announcements related to the Service and our other products and services;
- Deliver targeted advertisements, promotional messages, notices, and other information about products, events and services of ours, our affiliates and third parties, such as exhibitors, sponsors, licensees and media partners;
- Invite you to participate in promotions or other activities such as workshops;
- Identify usage trends and develop data analysis, including for purposes of research, audit, reporting and other business operations, including determining the effectiveness of our promotional campaigns and evaluating our business performance;
- Support health and safety at our events; and/or
- Comply with our legal obligations, resolve disputes, and enforce our agreements.

We may also use your information to:

- Provide relevant networking, speaker sessions, presentations, and exhibitor product recommendations as part of our event matchmaking services based on the preferences and interests you provide during your registration, your interactions on our websites, platforms, and at our events; and/or
- Include in participant directories to provide visitors, exhibitors, and sponsors names and business contact details of those attending the event.

## Sharing of Your Information

### Our Service Providers

Depending on the Service provided, we share personal information with:

- 5GOT 2025's event team and certain companies that provide technology, customer service and other shared services functions; and/or
- Our service providers, suppliers, agents and representatives, including but not limited to, payment processors, venue providers, onsite event contractors, customer support, email service providers, IT service providers, mailing houses and shipping agents, to process the information as necessary to provide the Service, complete a transaction, fulfil your request, or otherwise on our behalf based on our instructions and in compliance with this privacy policy and any other appropriate confidentiality and security measures.

### Your Choices

We share your personal information with 5GOT 2025 operation teams and with exhibitors, sponsors, media partners, joint venture partners and other third parties, including entities for which we are acting as an agent, licensee or event manager, that wish to send you information about their products and services that may be of interest to you, as determined by your choices in managing your own communications preferences and other personal settings.

The Service may include forums and participant directories that let you create a profile and post and share personal information, comments, materials and other content to help others connect with you. Any such contributions you disclose publicly may be collected and used by others, may be indexed by search engines, and might not be able to be removed. Please be careful when disclosing personal information in these public areas.

The Service may enable you to share your virtual 'business card' information with an exhibitor, sponsor or association by scanning the QR code on the event ID badge on a badge-scanning device at a booth or other event location.

When entering a virtual space, zone, or room at an event, your registration details may be shared with other attendees including the sponsor or exhibitor to facilitate event networking real-time video conferencing, online chats, and/or virtual business card drops, subject to additional notices.

When redeeming a voucher or invite to attend any of our events courtesy of our exhibitors or sponsors, we will share your registration details with the exhibitor or sponsor for billing and/or marketing related purposes.

## Legal Reasons

We will disclose your personal information if we have a good faith belief that such disclosure is necessary to:

- meet any applicable law, regulation, legal process or other legal obligation;
- detect, investigate and help prevent security, fraud or technical issues; and/or
- protect the rights, property, health or safety of Reed Exhibitions, our users, employees or others;

and as part of a corporate transaction, such as a transfer of assets or an acquisition by or merger with another company.

## Additional Processing

### Editorial Content and Event Presentations

Where you submit content, such as write an article or produce a video, for any of our publications or other products, or speak at one of our events, we will process some additional personal information about you, including:

- Professional biography or profile, produced or approved by you, that may contain your image, likeness, or voice, which may be published and made available to our subscribers, event audiences, or published online via our websites and social media channels for promotional purposes; and



- Internal editorial, reviewer, commentary, or feedback.

To help improve the diversity of our editorial content and event panels, we may ask you to provide, on an entirely voluntary basis, demographic data such as age, gender, disability, race, ethnic origin, religion and sexual orientation.

## Event Concierge

As part of our event concierge services for our hosted buyers, we may need to collect government identification information, such as passport and visa details, as well as any relevant health and disability information to ensure all accommodation, logistic and dietary requirements are met. This information may be provided to our local agents to secure the most suitable services based on their expert local knowledge. Where this is relevant, we would usually require your consent. However, there are some limited situations where this will not occur such as in a medical emergency

## Accessing and Updating Your Information

The Service may allow you to directly access and review your account, profile and participant directory information and make corrections, updates or deletions at any time. Keeping such information up to date is solely your responsibility. You may also close your account, delete your profile or remove your participant directory information by contacting the Service's customer support.

## Data Retention

We retain your personal information for as long as necessary to provide the Service and fulfil the transactions you have requested, or for other essential purposes such as complying with our legal obligations, maintaining business and financial records, resolving disputes, maintaining security, detecting and preventing fraud and abuse, and enforcing our agreements.

## Data Security

We take precautions to safeguard your personal information against loss, theft and misuse and unauthorised access, disclosure, alteration and destruction using appropriate technical and organisational measures.

## Grounds for Processing

When we collect from you any personal information within the scope of Malaysia Data Protection Act, we do so:

- where necessary to provide the Service, fulfil a transaction or otherwise perform a contract with you or at your request prior to entering into a contract;
- where necessary for our compliance with applicable law or other legal obligation;
- where necessary for the performance of a task carried out in the public interest;
- where necessary in order to protect your or another person's vital interests;
- where applicable, with your consent; and/or
- as necessary to operate our business, protect the security of our systems, customers and users, detect or prevent fraud, enable our customers to comply with legal obligations, or fulfil our other legitimate interests as described in the "How And Why Do We Collect Information?", "How We Use Your Information?" and "Sharing of Your Information" clauses above, except where our interests are overridden by your privacy rights.

Where we rely on your consent to process personal information, you have the right to withdraw your consent at any time, and where we rely on legitimate interests, you may have the right to object to our processing.
